

Marine Park Conservation Passport

The Cozumel National Marine Park Arrecifes de Cozumel is a federally protected area which visitors purchase Marine Park Pass to scuba dive, snorkel and enjoy the reefs and sandbars within the park.

If you plan on visiting the Marine Park more than 12 days per year then the annual Passport is the deal for you!!

To get your passport:

- 1.- Have a valid photo I.D. with you.
- 2.- Stop in at the Scuba Shack Dive Shop
- 3.- Pay the onetime fee of \$25 USD

It's a good idea to let us know you when you book your stay or dive trip that you are interested in the Passport. This way we will make sure to have them on hand when you arrive.

The card also helps to reduce trash in the Park. No more bracelets or those little tabs that cover sticky part floating around in the water.

REMEMBER, you will have to have the Passport and Photo ID with you on the boat every day go out diving
